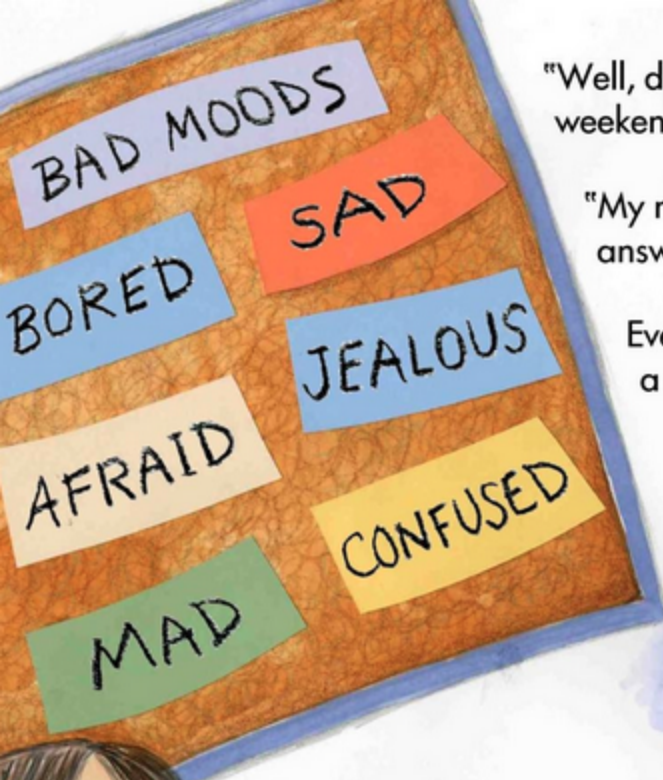

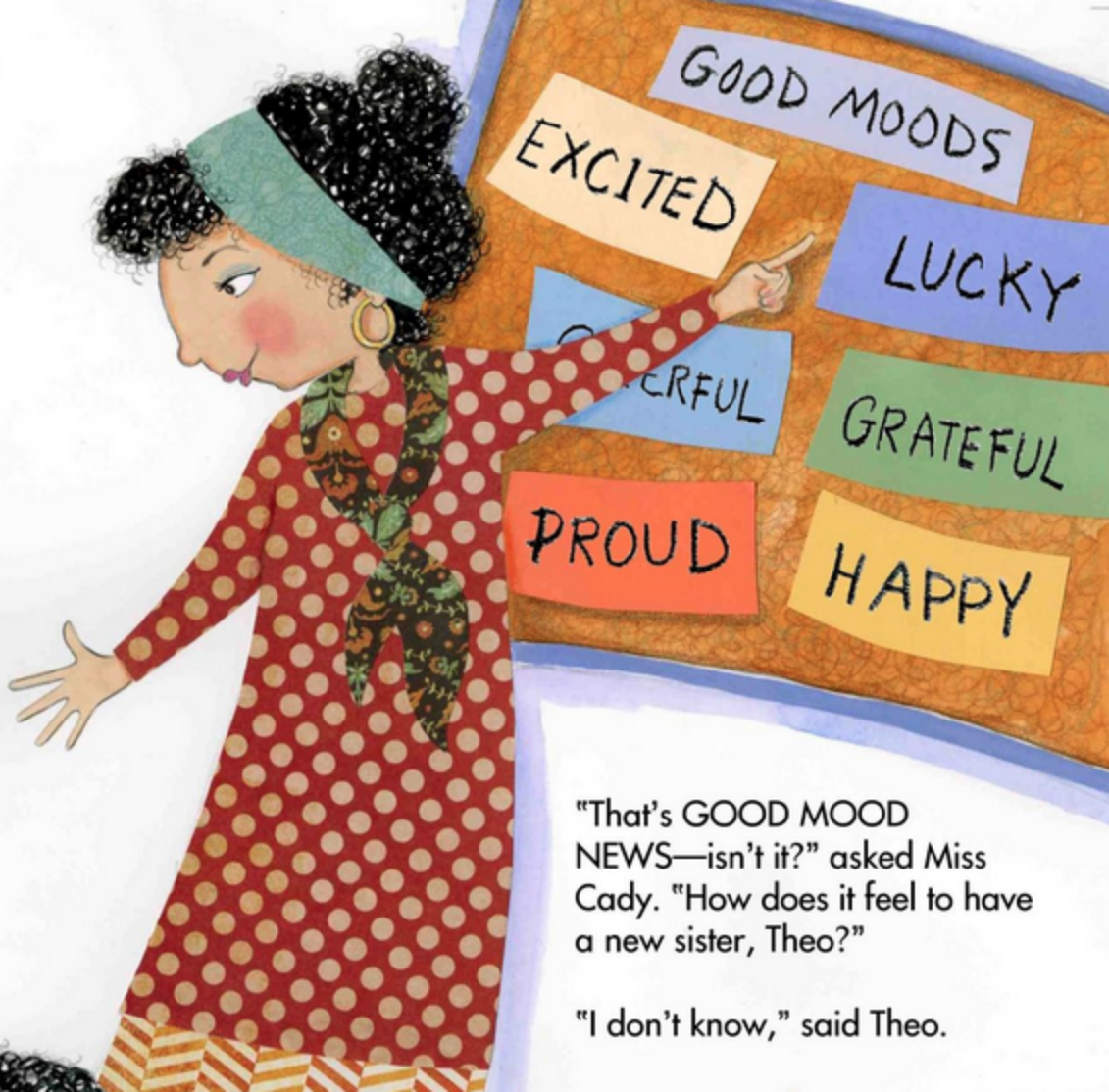
"Well, did anything happen this weekend?" asked Miss Cady.
